German delegation to visit Tanzania

DELEGATION of seven members of the Budget Committee of German parliament would pay a visit to Tanzania from April 20 to 26 this year.

According to a statement issued yesterday by the Germany Embassy, the delegation would be headed by Lothar Mark and would visit various places.

The statement said the main objective of the visit was to get an impression of the projects and works done by the Germany Armed Force Technical Advisory Group (GAFTAG) in the country.

The statement said GAFTAG works in the field of maintenance and modernisation projects in Lugalo Military Hospital and the Lugalo Workshop, as well as Military Hospitals in Mbeya, Mwanza and Arusha.

The delegation would visit the GAFTAG premises at Lugalo barracks on April 22 and the ongoing construction site of the military hospital in Bububu Zanzibar on April 23 this year.

The statement said the delegation would also visit Hotel Training School of the Hanns-Seidel Foundation, a German Non Governmental organization in Arusha on April 24.
